## **Modern Spacious Clubhouse**

- A large Wardroom and lounge with panoramic views over the Marina and Waikawa Bay.
- Full Bar facilities, when open for meals or during Club or sporting functions.
- Restaurant meals are available every Friday, Sunday evenings during the winter and after sailing on Tuesdays and Thursdays in summer.
- Shower, laundry and toilet facilities are available to senior members 24/7.
- Hire our venue at member only discounted rates for weddings, parties or conferences.
- Our Club Manager is available on 03 573 6798, if no reply please leave a message and you will be contacted.

## **Secure Moorings**

- The club owns over 98 secure, well maintained moorings throughout Queen Charlotte Sound, Pelorus Sound and D'Urville Island for the use of our Senior members. These moorings are jointly shared with the Mana and Pelorus Boating Clubs to spread the cost of maintenance and to give you greater mooring options for your enjoyment. Some of these moorings are owned by Outward Bound who have reciprocal use of our moorings.

## **Yacht Racing**

- The Yacht Racing Programme runs through the full year and caters for all levels of ability. With Twilight racing on Tuesdays through summer, regattas, the wine race to Wellington, coastal races, short-handed racing and the Sunday Winter Series. Plus the popular Lean to sail series held over summer on Thursday evenings as well as the more social Business House Series there is always something happening on the water.

## **Cruising Division**

- Cruises vary from social overnight 'raft-up's at a designated location to week long cruises to D'Urville Island and Pelorus Sound and further afield if several boats wish to take part.
- Yachts and launches and trailer boats are all encouraged to join in.
- Annual beach clean up to go ashore and remove rubbish from beaches where we have moorings is completed each year.
- Mooring dives are undertaken each year where the seafloor around our moorings is cleaned from rubbish.

## **Marina Berths**

- The Club leases a marina berth in front of the Clubhouse for the use of members and visitors.
- There is a charge of \$2 per metre per day of boat length with a minimum charge of \$15 per day. The marina berth is booked on a first in first berthed system by calling the club office.

## **General**

- The club has an active Executive, working hard to ensure the smooth running of the Club.
- The Waikawa Boating Club is affiliated to Yachting New Zealand and as such, is under the umbrella of the National Association, which lobbies Government hard, to help all recreational boaties.
- The Club publishes a weekly email newsletter to keep you up to date with club activities and other items of interest including a members section.

The following may belong to the club as a Crew member:

- a. Any person who wishes to crew on a boat belonging to a senior member of the club
- b. Any person who does not own or is not in permanent charge of a boat.
- c. Crew membership may be a Single or Couple membership
- d. Any person who owns a boat not capable of staying overnight and in the case of a yacht, does not race.
- e. Such persons who qualify as a Crew member will pay the subscription and any joining fee at the time of joining.
- f. Any Crew member who wishes to upgrade to a senior member must pay the current joining fee and subscription for that membership. Such fees may be rebated in part by the current crew membership subscription provided that the crew membership subscription for that season has been paid prior to the upgrade taking place.
- g. Crew members will not have the right to vote or hold office in any elected position within the club.

### **Social Membership** **\$ 44.70**

**YNZ Affiliation Levy – per person** **\$ 25.30**

**Total Social Member** **\$ 70.00**

The following may belong to the Club as a Social member:

- a. Any person who does not own a boat which is permanently moored in Queen Charlotte Sounds. Such a person will be entitled to Social membership.
- b. Social membership will be recorded as single or couple membership.
- c. Social members will pay the current subscription and any applicable levy.
- d. Any Social member who wishes to upgrade to a senior member must pay the current joining fee and subscription for that membership. Such fees may be rebated in part by the current Social membership subscription provided that the Social membership subscription for that season has been paid prior to the upgrade taking place.
- e. Social members will not have the right to vote or hold office in any elected position within the club.
- f. Social members will not have the right to use club moorings at any time unless accompanied by a senior member of the club and flying both club burgee and current year pennant.
- g. Social members may not be issued with club keys.

### **Senior Temporary Membership** **\$150.00**

Includes Club burgee, year flag and mooring map and is valid for a 2 month period only.

Senior Temporary Membership is available for people and their boats residing either north of 39 degree south latitude or south of 45 degrees south latitude. Their intention is to cruise Marlborough with their boat for a season and to use the Club facilities and moorings. A Senior Temporary Member may join by paying the subscribed fee for a period of two months, and completing the membership application form.

Note - If the member wishes to extend their temporary membership they must join as a full Senior member and pay joining fee and balance of Senior membership subscription plus any levy.
