## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T will apply.

### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Fifteen Class that comply with their class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of their Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Nationals Regatta 2018, Waikawa Boating Club, P. O. Box 52, Picton 7220, or by emailing the contest entry form to [office@waikawaboatingclub.co.nz](mailto:office@waikawaboatingclub.co.nz) by Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2018.



**3.3** Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee of \$30 may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 1700 hours on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

**3.4** To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant's and crew member's national authority.

Proof of affiliated club membership to be presented at registration.

**3.5** Each competitor, entrant and crew members shall be Flying Fifteen Class Association.

**4.1** Required fees are as follows:

**5.1** Registration: Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018 from 1300 to 1700 hours.

**5.2** Equipment inspection and event measurement: Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018 from 1300 to 1700 hours.

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1030.

5.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1530.

## 6 MEASUREMENT

6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

6.2 Boats may be weighed, and other measurements and inspections may be undertaken to ensure boats meet class rules and safety regulations. Any sails not previously signed will be measured.

## 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration, from 1300 hours on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2018, at the Waikawa Boating Club.

## 8 VENUE

8.1 The venue is the Queen Charlotte Sounds.

8.2 Attachment "A" shows the location of the racing areas.

## 9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed may be any combinations of Trapezoid, Triangle/Windward/Leeward and/or Windward/Leeward legs.

## 10 SCORING

10.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

b) When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 11 SUPPORT BOATS

Team support boats will be allowed. Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration.

**12 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park.

**13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A competing yacht shall for safety purposes carry a working VHF on channel 77. Boats shall neither make nor receive radio communications while racing. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

**14 PRIZES**

Tauranga Trophy – 1<sup>st</sup> place Silver Fleet, pre 3500 sail numbers

Leatham Edmond Memorial Trophy - First male/female crew

Spencer Salver - Best Placed Helm over 55 years

Pinkies Pot - Top Fleet on Average Points

Improvers Trophy (Presented by Rowell Winters) - Improvement During Regatta

Trustbank Handicap Cup - Time corrected handicap scores

Craddock Cup - Improvement from previous Nationals (points difference)

Sam Mason Memorial Trophy - Invitation Race/Race 1

Other prizes may also be awarded.

**15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
