Race Management Team

The Race Management Team (RMT) normally comprises 5-6 volunteers on Waikawa Boating Club's Committee Boat "Ray White". The team are rostered on according to their availability. Single races take about 4 hours to run. You are slightly compensated for your time with food and drink vouchers. The team usually has fun on board.

Each person takes one of these 4 positions:

1. **Race Officer.** The Race Officer is responsible for running successful races to YNZ rules and regulations. The Race Officer will have completed, at a minimum, the YNZ Club Race Officer online learning (<https://www.yachtingnz.org.nz/clubs/embark-online-learning>) and will work with our YNZ qualified skippers until they are proficient. It helps to have had experience racing.
2. **Skipper.** The skipper is responsible for the crew and "Ray White". They will have a minimum of the "Day Skipper" qualification and will have spent time on "Ray White" and become proficient in driving it. 6 monthly "refreshers" with the bosun are required. The skipper will help the crew once the course is laid and the boat is anchored.
3. **Sailwave Results and Scoring.** If you have a mathematical mind and like software this is the position for you. Training is required to run the Sailwave software. This will be provided.
4. **Crew.** No qualifications are required. You will be responsible for helping lay the course and the flags.
